



Costco Wholesale Corporation Reports May Sales Results

June 6, 2013

ISSAQUAH, WA -- (Marketwired) -- 06/06/13 -- Costco Wholesale Corporation ("Costco" or the "Company") (NASDAQ: COST) today reported net sales of \$8.13 billion for the month of May, the four weeks ended June 2, 2013, an increase of seven percent from \$7.57 billion during the similar period last year.

For the thirty-nine weeks ended June 2, 2013, the Company reported net sales of \$77.13 billion, an increase of eight percent from \$71.28 billion during the similar period last year.

Comparable sales for the four-week and 39-week periods ended June 2, 2013, were as follows:

Changes in gasoline prices and foreign exchange rates had negative impacts on comparable sales for the four-week period; and immaterial impacts for the 39-week period. Excluding these effects, comparable sales were as follows:

Costco currently operates 627 warehouses, including 449 in the United States and Puerto Rico, 85 in Canada, 33 in Mexico, 24 in the United Kingdom, 15 in Japan, nine in Taiwan, nine in Korea and three in Australia. The Company plans to open up to an additional nine new warehouses prior to the end of its fiscal year on September 1, 2013.
